Mainly because the results are just so natural. The treatment creates fine hair like strokes to fill, enhance and improve the shape of your natural eyebrows, creating a natural beautiful result. Using a pen like tool outfitted with up to 16 microscopic needles, adding specialise pigments to the skin. A topical anaesthetic is also used for you complete comfort. The technique of Microblading is a kind of shallow tattoo, where the sine hair like strokes are placed within the epidermis and subcutaneous layers of the skin. This skill prevents blurring & discolouration that can occur with traditional tattooing methods that penetrate the dermal layer of the skin. All tools are disposable and sterile packed. You will need 2 treatments and in rare cases 3. They can be spaced 4-6 weeks apart as your eyebrows need to fully heal between sessions. Allow 2-2.5 hours for your treatment, it may not take this long, but is intended so we do not have to rush perfection. During your treatment we will plan, discuss & design your brow enhancement with you, as well as covering all contraindications and precautions associated with Microblading. This is a very safe procedure that creates stunning results.
